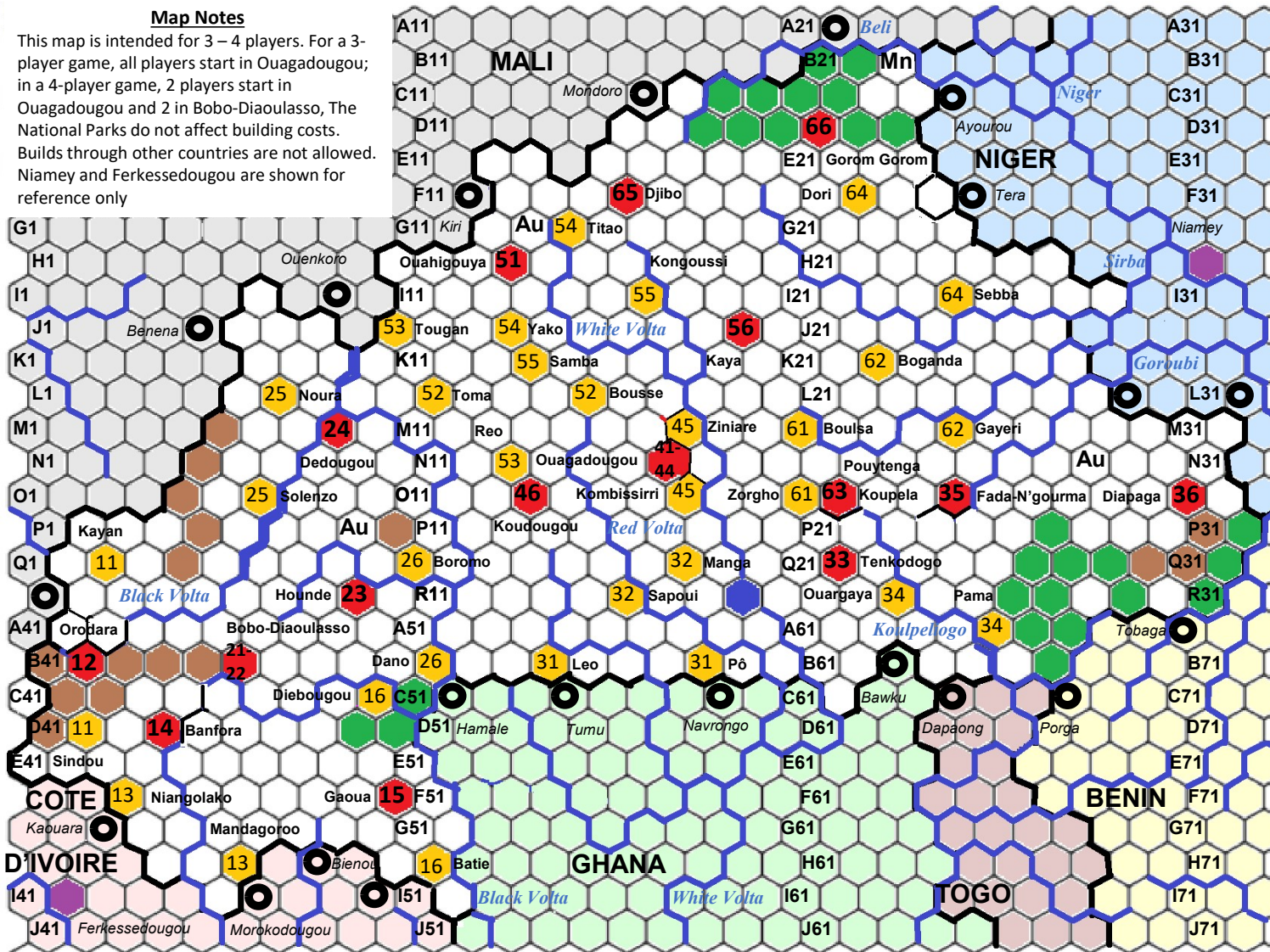






Map Notes

This map is intended for 3 – 4 players. For a 3-player game, all players start in Ouagadougou; in a 4-player game, 2 players start in Ouagadougou and 2 in Bobo-Diaoulasso. The National Parks do not affect building costs. Builds through other countries are not allowed. Niamey and Ferkessedougou are shown for reference only

BURKINA FASO

Burkina Faso (formerly the Republic of Upper Volta) is located in Western Africa. A former French colony, it gained independence as Upper Volta in 1960. The name Burkina Faso, which means "Land of Incorruptible People," was adopted in 1984. The country occupies an extensive plateau, and its geography is characterized by a savannah that is grassy in the north and gradually gives way to sparse forests in the south. Tena Kourou is the country's highest point at 749 meters above sea level. The main rivers are the Black Volta, Red Volta and White Volta.

Administratively, Burkina Faso is divided into 13 regions and 45 provinces. All the provincial Capitals have been represented on this map. Railway Rivals is a game designed by David Watts and published by Rostherne Games. This map was designed by Jim Reader in September 2020 with input from Bob Gingell and Richard Smith.

1. Cote D'Ivoire
 2. Ghana (1-3) or Togo (4-6)
 3. Niger (1-3) or Benin (4-6)
 4. Mali
 5. Gold (1-3) or Manganese (4-6)
 6. National Park hex
- Gold is located at Au hexes, plus Sebba, Kongoussi and Manga. Manganese is at B23.
