4 players: 2 each at Kaesong and Sinuiju

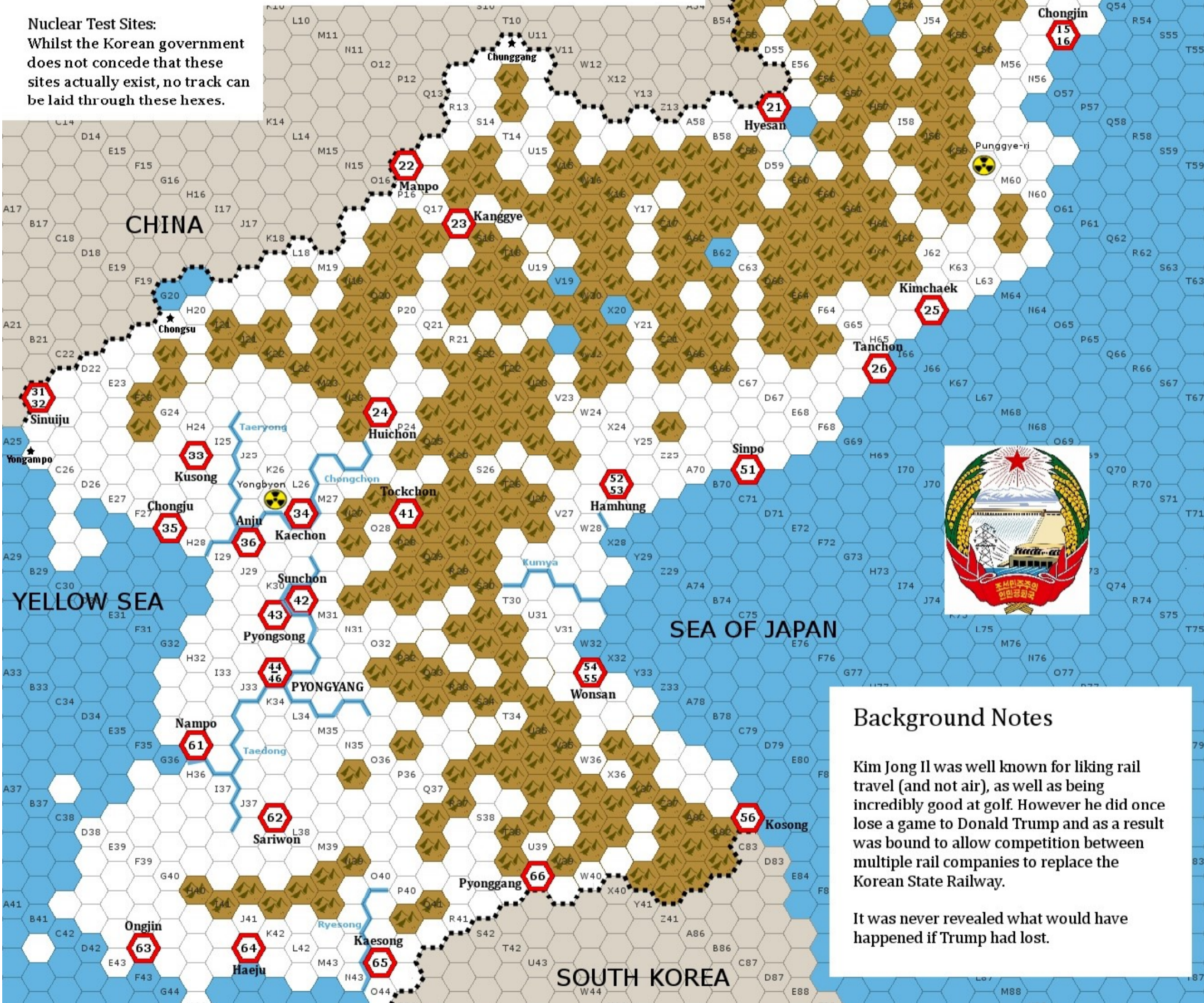
5 players: 2 at Kaesong, 2 at Sinuiju, 1 at Onsong



Special Runs: 1 = China Liaoning (Sinuiju, Chongsu) 2= China Jilin (Manpo, Chunggang, Onsong); 3 = Russia (Tumangang, Rason); 4 = Western Seaport (Yongampo, Nampo, Ongjin); 5 = Eastern Seaport (Chong-jin, Tanchon, Sinpo, Wonsan); 6 = South Korea (Kaseong, Pyonggang, Kosong).
